

- Displayed when received in standardized formats (ex: ICD-10 Conditions)

PAMI - Download/Printing Limitation

- Data on the **PDMP** tab & **Immunizations** tab can be downloaded or printed using “Download PDF” button in top right
- **Problems, Allergies & Reported Medications** cannot be downloaded or printed using a button.



Possible Workarounds:

1. Take screenshots of the data and paste into Word (or similar).
2. If the data you are looking to print is minimal, use search or filter to narrow the view to **just** that item and attempt to print [**Control P**] to PDF. Depending on your browser settings and your zoom settings, it might fit on the screen [*but this is very limited*].
