



CurrentCare® Services

The following Health Information Exchange (HIE) services will be available to providers in CurrentCare **starting in Spring 2025**. **Learn more at: CurrentCareRI.org.**

SERVICE	DESCRIPTION
Clinical Data (Portal)	Enables users to access critical health information about patients, including medication data, lab results, radiology reports, encounter information and more through the web-based Portal .
InContext (Clinical Data within EHR)	Enables users to access critical health information about patients, including medication data, lab results, radiology reports, encounter information and more within the EHR (depending upon the vendor capability).
Encounter Notifications	Enables users to receive real time alerts for patient healthcare events (hospital admissions, discharges, etc.). These alerts are delivered through CSS Event Notification Delivery (CEND) in various formats, including Population Explorer, Data Extracts, ADT Feeds, HL7 messages (raw and templated) and others.
Panel Processor	Enables users to upload patient panel files to the HIE for Event notifications, Clinical Portal, etc.
Consent Tool	Enables users to register consents on behalf of their patients such as opting in to <i>Disclose 42 CFR Part 2 - Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment Information</i> .
PDMP	Provides prescribers access to the RI PDMP and other states , which monitors controlled substances dispensed by RI prescribers.
Conditions of Participation: Alternative Events System (CARES)	Hospitals can elect to send notifications to Primary Care Providers when their patient has an Inpatient or ED encounter, if the provider does not already have an attributed relationship with the patient.
Query Retrieve	User can view a summary of patients' CurrentCare record within certain EHRs including conditions, medications, allergies, and lab results.
HIE Admin Tool	HIE Administrators manage user access : add/remove user accounts, manage access to services, and perform 90-day audits.
