Data Limitations

- Patients who have “Opted Out” of data sharing
- Migration to new platform & data

Encounter Notifications are not available for patients who have “Opted Out” of CurrentCare data sharing. Read more about “Opt Out” [here](#).

CurrentCare is starting with new encounter data in Spring 2025 due to a migration to a new platform. This means that previous encounter history will be very limited. Please keep this in mind when viewing Encounter history and visit totals from ER, inpatient and observation visit totals.
